  - *provides veterans, unemployed, and underemployed professionals with a training*

  - *Additional Assistance for 1 year of training including housing*
- **Information Technology Training for Tomorrow (IT<sup>3</sup>)**
  - *US Dept. of Labor – partnered with CPD – Cyber-Security Training Grant*

  - *NSF Grant Partnered with UHCL for paid student tutors – SJC & UHCL*
